The following will need to be submitted.

- Parental permission form
- Student's social media links (including Facebook, Instagram, TikTok, etc.)
- One archery related writing sample (up to 600 words)
- One teacher or coach recommendation letter
- Cover letter including:
 - Why you want to be a NASP® Student Contributor
 - Your archery experience to date
 - What archery related topics you may want to focus on

About our decision:

Our final decision will be based on which submissions that we believe meet the NASP® mission and operating principles, as well as who is the best fit for our team.

The student contributor role is a 5 month long commitment, which extends past a normal school archery season. If you are unsure you will be able to make this commitment but would like to opportunity to provide content as a guest, please complete the above application and note that you would like to be a guest writer.

- 3. School appropriate
- 4. Focus on NASP® archery
- 5. Written with a positive attitude
- 6. Include written photo permission for anyone pictured

NASP® reserves the right to edit or remove submissions at any time.

Brainstorming:

- How can I engage my reader?
- What have I seen recently that I thought, "I wish that archer/person knew this".
- Is there a personal struggle I am working with or have overcome that others could relate to?

Submission Checklist:

Ш	Submission is between 300-600 words
	Submission is broken down into digestible sections (paragraphs) to increase understanding of the reader.
	Check for run on sentences and proper punctuation. Read your submission outloud to yourself, a parent, sibling or friend to check for clarity.
	Spell-check entire document
	A title that is specific, uses keywords, and concise but eye catching and creative
	Includes at least 2 archery related images sent as JPEG or PNG. Or, 1 NASP® related shooting video less than 15 seconds.
	Include 3-4 sentences introducing your submission for social media
