## 2021 NASP® Open/Championship Bullseye

Myrtle Beach Convention Center and Sports Center

Open tournament June 10

Championship tournament June 11- 12

### TOURNAMENT DETAILS:

- NASP® Bullseye tournament: Myrtle Beach Convention Center
  - 2101 North Oak Street S, Myrtle Beach, SC <https://www.myrtlebeachconventioncenter.com/>
- Parking: \$5.00 per day for car, \$10.00 per day per bus
- Admission – Adults \$10, Youth 13-18 \$5, and 12 and under is free. Keep entry wrist strap because admission covers all 3 days of event. (Registered archers & coaches are free.)
- Myrtle Beach Convention Center and Myrtle Beach Sports Center do not allow carry in food or drink.
- Registration fee: \$35/archer (3 coaches free/team...1 coach free/individual group) – due by June 4th

### General Notes:

- **NEW FOR 2021:** Teams and individuals are responsible for providing their own arrows for these events.
- **NEW FOR 2021: Auto Flight Selection will be utilized for this event.** For more information on Auto Flight Selection visit <https://www.naspschools.org/wp-content/uploads/AutoFlightSelection.pdf>
  - During pre-registration schools will pick flight preferences.
  - Flights will be auto selected for each school based on score and place of finish in the national tournament and flight preferences entered during pre-registration.
  - Each school will have an opportunity to review selected flights before full registration and change/add/drop flights during full registration if needed and as space permits.
  - Schools will be financially responsible for all flight positions assigned and not dropped by the drop by date.
  - The Auto Flight Selection process will assign all archers to the NASP® bullseye flights first. It will then assign archers to the NASP®-IBO 3D flights ensuring that there is a minimum of one flight spacing between flight times for Bullseye and 3D flight times.
- Waivers will be required for all participants.

### **CHAMPIONSHIP TOURNAMENT: June 11 – 12:**

**Registration:** Go to: [www.nasptournaments.org](http://www.nasptournaments.org) All Times Eastern Standard (EST)

#### **Registration Criteria:**

- Teams will receive highest priority for flight assignment.
  - Teams will be ranked for flight assignment by their score and place of finish in the Virtual National tournament.
  - Only teams that generated a team score in the Virtual National tournament are eligible.
- Individuals will be placed after qualified teams.

- Individual groups will be ranked for flight assignment based on the highest-ranking archer in the individual group based on Virtual National tournament scores.
- The Top 100 individual boys and girls, from each division, including ties, as determined from the 2021 Virtual National tournament.

**Pre-registration:** Monday, April 24 at 8AM – Wednesday, May 12 at 5PM EST

- **\*\*\*New for 2021** – Championship registration will use a new Auto Flight Selection process...see “General Notes” above.
- Only schools that select flight preferences during pre-registration will receive flight selections during the auto-flight selection. **It is critical that a school selects ALL flight times that they are willing to accept.**
  - Only qualified teams and individuals will be assigned to flights.
    - Teams **MUST** register as a qualified team.
      - Bullseye – 12-24 archers and at least 4 of each gender
    - Individual groups may only include qualified archers.
      - If the individual group contains ANY archers not qualified to register, NO archers in the group will be assigned to flight times.

**Registration:** Access opens on Thurs, May 13<sup>th</sup> at 8AM to edit your flights and roster that were auto selected

- If a team size is adjusted below the minimum team size, the team will be removed, and the coach will be responsible for registering them as individuals in the Open.
- If an unqualified individual is added to an individual group, that archer will be removed from the Championship and the coach will be responsible for registering them for the Open.
- DROP BY DATE/TIME 1:00pm Friday May 14<sup>th</sup>...this is the deadline to drop flight positions. You are responsible to pay registration fee for all flight positions you have registered at this time.
- Registration will close at 5:00 pm EST on Friday, May 14

## **OPEN TOURNAMENT- June 10:**

**This event is open to all NASP® archers, even if they have not been a part of a tournament before.**

If you are an actively participating NASP® school, your archers can participate in the tournament. Even if you did not participate in the 2021 Virtual National Tournament.

You can go to [www.nasptournaments.org](http://www.nasptournaments.org), log in (must be a basic archery instructor to log in) by clicking on “log in” at the top right. Once in, click on “tournaments”, scroll down to “NASP® Open,” click on NASP® Open, then on “Registration & Info,” follow the links to pre-register your archers. The same process can be completed if you would like to participate in the NASP® IBO 3-D Open. You can participate in one or both events.

### **Registration Criteria:**

- Registration in the Open tournament is limited to archers NOT registered for the Championship tournament.
  - If an archer is participating in the Championship, that archer may NOT participate on a team or in an individual group in the Open.
- Teams will receive highest priority for flight assignment.
  - Teams will be ranked for flight assignment by their score and place of finish in the National tournament.
  - Teams that did not participate in or generate a team score in the National tournament will be randomly selected after ranked teams.
- Individuals will be placed after teams.
  - Individual groups will be ranked for flight assignment based on the highest-ranking archer in the individual group based on National tournament scores.

- Individual groups that contain no archers from the National tournament will be randomly selected after ranked individuals.

**Pre-registration:** Monday, April 26 at 8AM – Saturday, May 15<sup>th</sup> at 4PM EST - Pre-register all of your archers during this time by logging into [www.nasptournaments.org](http://www.nasptournaments.org) as mentioned above. Select all possible times your archers may be able to shoot.

- **\*\*\*New for 2021** – Open registration will use a new Auto Flight Selection process...see “General Notes” above
- Only schools that select flight preferences during pre-registration will receive flight selections during the auto-flight selection. **It is critical that a school selects ALL flight times that they are willing to accept.**

**Registration:** Access opens on Sunday, May 16<sup>th</sup> at 8AM to edit your flights and roster that were auto selected

- DROP BY DATE/TIME Monday, May 17<sup>th</sup>, 1:00pm...this is the deadline to drop flight positions. You are responsible to pay registration fee for all flight positions you have registered at this time.
- Registration will close at 5PM EST on Monday, May 17<sup>th</sup>

### Advancement from the Open tournament to the Championship tournament:

- **NASP® Bullseye**
  - The 1<sup>st</sup> place team in each division (elem, middle, high) in the Open will advance to the Championship.
  - The top 10 boys and the top 10 girls in each division (including ties) in the Open will advance to the Championship.
  - These advancing archers will be assigned to shoot in the 8:30 am flight on Friday, June 11<sup>th</sup>.

### SCHOLARSHIP CHANGES:

- **NEW FOR 2021:** For the first time in any in-person National level event NASP® will be providing random scholarships at the Open Championship. One archer in every flight of the Open and the Championship will be randomly selected to receive a \$500.00 scholarship.
- **Scholarship Shoot-off:** In the past qualification for the Championship tournament and the scholarship shoot-off have been based on National tournament results. Due to limitations presented by COVID and the changes of the 2021 national tournament being virtual, qualification for the 2021 Championship will be participation in the virtual national. The scholarship shoot-off for 2021 will be determined by scores at the championship.
- The top 5 boys and top 5 girls at the championship tournament will be invited to participate in the scholarship shoot-off. The results of the shoot-off will determine scholarship awards of: (for both boys and girls).
  - 1<sup>ST</sup> PLACE \$5,000.00
  - 2<sup>ND</sup> PLACE \$4,000.00
  - 3<sup>RD</sup> PLACE \$3,000.00
  - 4<sup>TH</sup> PLACE \$2,000.00
  - 5<sup>TH</sup> PLACE \$1,000.00
- If there are ties in the top five places of each gender, those archers will also be invited to participate in the shoot-off.

\* Must have valid BAI number, username & password for on-line registration access.

\*\* Once registration closes for the Championship (May 14) and the Open (May 17), you are responsible to submit payment for all archers you have registered. Payment is due by June 4<sup>th</sup>.

\*\*\* Changes after registration close must be addressed on site 1 hour or more before flight time.

\*\*\*\* No archer or team is guaranteed participation at NASP® Open and Championships. When flights fill according to the tiered schedule above the tournament will be closed.
